

Dear Handmade Life began on a Southern California backyard patio over margaritas, first emerging as a tiny, holiday craft festival called Patchwork Show. The show drew huge crowds and proved that a dose of creativity and community was just what the world needed.

Over the next decade, Patchwork Show evolved into a multi-city, biannual festival. In 2011, the Craftcation Conference was launched, giving small-business owners and creatives support and education through four magical days of craft, business and wellness workshops at the beach.

With the additions of a blog, podcast, online shop and workshops, as well as a thriving virtual community, the brand became Dear Handmade Life in 2013.

Today, Nicole and the Dear Handmade Life team of badass, creative women curate events, education and community for creative misfits, passionate small-business owners and DIY devotees.




